❖ Semi-finalists will be interviewed in early May. If selected, you will be notified of the specific day and time of the interview. Notification will be sent to the e-mail address which you provided in the application.

Required Materials submitted in one envelope:

- 2 COPIES Walpole Scholarship Foundation High School application and essay**
 - Filled out by applicant and answered all questions
 - Answered and typed the essay question

- 2 COPIES of official SAT or ACT score report**
 - Copy of College Board letter notification of scores or printout from the College Board website.
 - Multiple letters may be submitted. Highlight the scores you want us to consider for each category.

- 2 COPIES of an official, certified transcript from all High Schools attended**
 - The second copy may be a photocopy of the certified transcript.

- 2 COPIES of a letter of reference from a High School Teacher**
 - Ask your teacher to include information that would assist the Foundation in knowing a little more about you and why you should be considered for a scholarship.
 - The second copy may be a photocopy of the original letter.

- 2 COPIES of the first page FAFSA Student Aid Report (SAR)**
 - Page 1 of your FAFSA Student Aid Report (SAR) showing name, address and EFC.
 - You may blacken any other information out.
 - See separate instructions filling out FAFSA and printing SAR.

All financial information will be confidential.

Strict confidentiality will be observed in dealing with all financial information. The only financial information made available to the entire Scholarship Selection Committee will be the amount of "expected family contribution (EFC)."
